### 8. Coach Clabough

Facility looks great

Evaluation of players – the coaches have been working on new evaluation methods that Andy brought back from camp. The system works like this:

Rating scale from 2 – 8

A 5 score is an average Sunset League player performing at the Varsity level

Position Players – rated on 5 categories

Hitting (BA .395 = 8, /360+ = 7 etc)

Hitting for power (# HRs)

Running (H to 1<sup>st</sup>, 4.2 or better = 8)

Fielding

Throwing (velocity)

A Division 1 Player would be an 8, (or after calculations a 65 or above) probably best on team

Also consider present playing ability and future playing ability (OFP = overall future potential) High school focuses more on the present, play after that is more on the future.

Every player will receive a report, please do not compare and discuss

The scores are added together and doubled for the report, so 5 (5s) = 25 x 2 = 50

The players are also evaluated on Player efficiency

Work attitude/Ethic

Attention to Detail

Dedication

Coaches will discuss the results with each player, the players will have an opportunity to comment. There are adjustments to scores based on field skills during games and Varsity and JV playing history.

Pitchers are evaluated based upon attitude, work and the different type of pitches that they throw.
