At this time, we have about \$10,000 left in our account, however we will go forward with at least a \$20,000 deficit. Flynn is working on the projected budget now and will have more information. We were very aggressive this year on projects and spent about \$50,000. We have remaining bills to pay for transportation (2007), banquet costs and stipends. The fence is almost completed we still have to install the tarps/screens but right now we don't have the funds. Alternate transportation methods will be considered for next year. Todd mentioned that we could have held off on projects but he and Coach Clabough decided that they would go ahead. They agree that it's not unusual for a Booster Club to carry a deficit and Todd believes we will catch up in September 08 when we receive dues. Next year we will only laser level the field and possible paint. Todd says we will not raise dues.

Field Maintenance is \$2300 per month (approx) this includes fees for Murphy and Yonaki, seed, lawn mower, fertilizer.
