Flynn stated that we are now current on past debt. We made about \$7 thousand on the Silent Auction at TFLA (about \$4 thousand of this was from credit card sales and is not shown on the income/expense statement as we don't have the \$\$ yet) We made \$ 6500 from ticket sales, approximately \$2600 of this will be distributed to families in the form of player credits for selling tickets,\$3900 will go to the Baseball Program. We have sold about 9 banners. A renewal of a banner is using the same banner, if someone wants a new banner they have to pay the new banner price.

Thank you to everyone who paid their dues in full, this helped us pay off our invoices. We had just under 20 families that paid their dues in full.
